# National 4



# The aim of the course is to encourage communicative competence in German.

There are two units to be completed for the course:

- Understanding Language
- Using Language
- Added Value Unit

Pupils will develop the skills of Listening and Talking and Reading and Writing which will allow them to:

- understand written and spoken German within a range of specified contexts: Society, Learning,
  Culture and Employability,
- apply and adapt familiar language in written and spoken German to make themselves readily understood,
- carry out an assignment, demonstrating their ability to use the four language skills of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.

#### Assessment:

- This course will be formally assessed by teaching staff using resources provided by SQA in the skills of Listening, Talking, Reading and Writing. Pupils must pass one assessment in each skill.
- In the Added Value Unit, pupils will be assessed on each of the four skills.
- There is no external assessment of this course and therefore no exam as part of the SQA diet.
- Regular formative assessment will continue.
- Listening and Talking will be assessed through role play/transactional tasks/group discussions and/or through conversations between pupil and teacher.
- Reading and Listening will be assessed through pupils' responses to written and spoken texts in German.
- Writing will be assessed regularly with pupils preparing a selection of pieces which may include simple reports, reviews and/or informative texts.



### Progression pathway:

Pupils who attain National 4 may be able to advance to National 5. Pupils are encouraged to discuss their progress with the Languages' Department.

#### Resources:

- Pupils have access to core vocabulary and notes in the form of booklets linked to a range of topic.
- Audio files to assist with the learning of vocabulary are also available online.
- Links to useful web-sites will be made available to pupils e.g <u>www.dw.de</u>, <u>www.yesgerman.com</u>; <u>www.goethe.de/prj/dfd/en/home.cfm</u>
- Traditional dictionaries and grammar reference books are supplemented by online versions, eg. <a href="https://www.pons.de">www.pons.de</a>
- Access to a range of websites allows up-to-date topics to be studied for personal interest and enjoyment e.q. current stories in the news.
- Pupils should take advantage of opportunities to engage with fluent speakers when possible.
- BBC Bitesize has been updated in line with National Courses.
